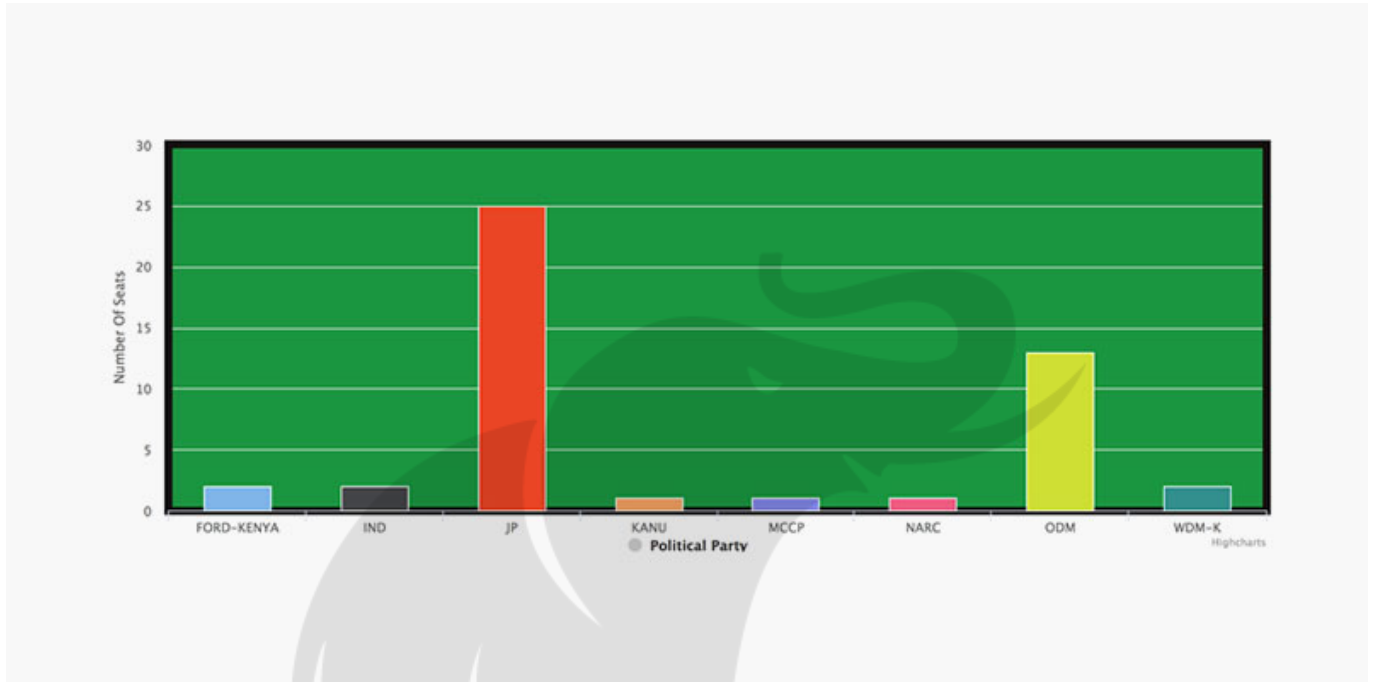




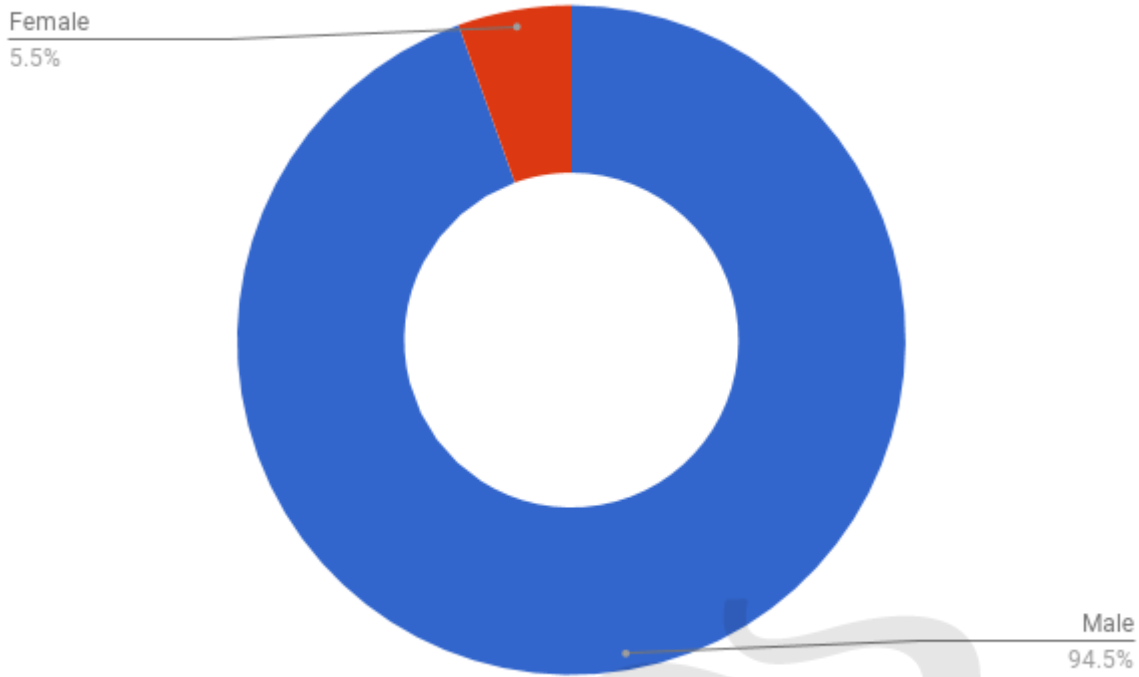

Race for Governor

Jubilee party won 25 Governors seats, followed by Orange Democratic Party, 13 seats. Two candidates **Mohamed A. Kuti** of Isiolo and **Ndiritu Muriithi** of Laikipia defied the odds and won as **Independents**

3 out of the **10** women who run for Governor were successful. **Anne Waiguru** (Jubilee/Kirinyaga) **Joyce Laboso** (Jubilee/Bomet) and **Charity Ngilu** (NARC/Kitui) beat their male counterparts to make history as Kenya's first female County Governors.

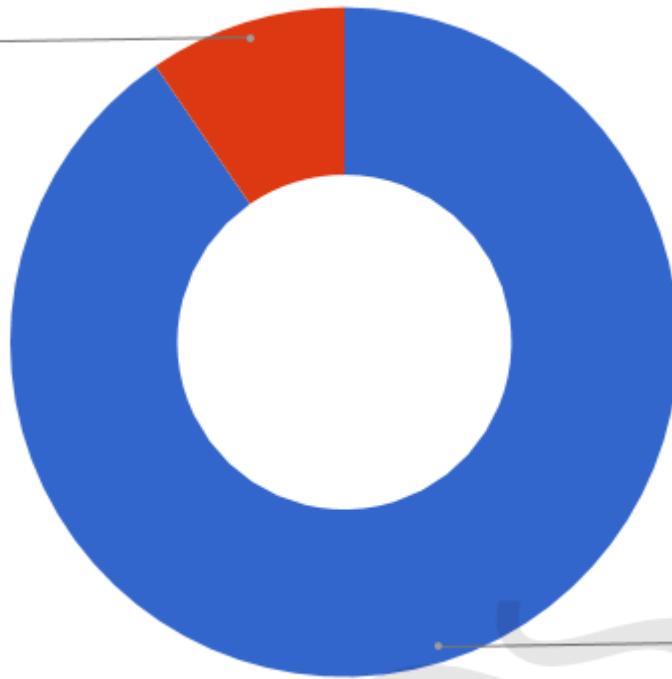

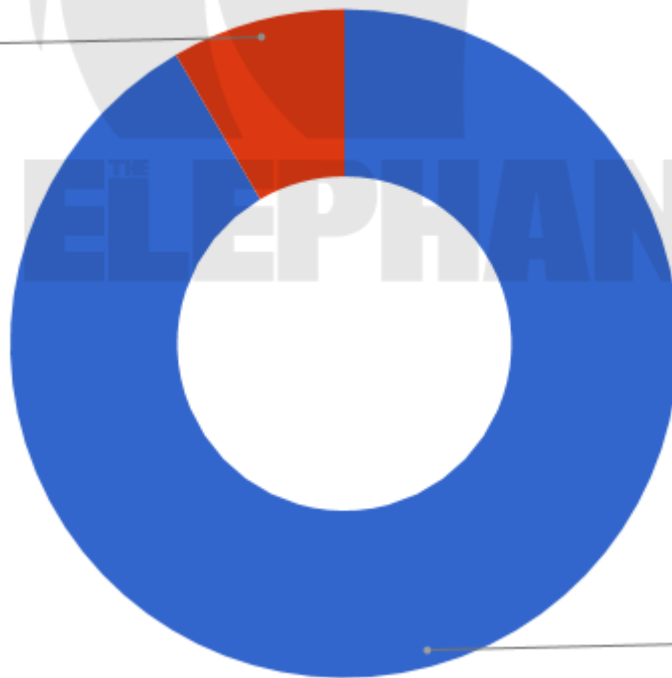
