**NOTICE OF REMOVAL OF ALL CAMPAIGN MATERIALS TO ALL CANDIDATES,  
POLITICAL PARTIES, AGENTS AND MEMBERS WHO SUPPORT POLITICAL  
PARTIES**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by Article 88(4) the Constitution of Kenya, Section 110 of the Elections Act, 2011, Paragraph 5(j)(ix) of the Second Schedule to the Elections Act, 2011, the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission **HEREBY GIVES NOTICE** to all candidates, agents, political parties and party members; that following the conclusion of General Elections conducted on the 8<sup>th</sup> of August, 2017: you are required to remove all banners, billboards, placards and posters erected during the election period within seven (7) days of this Notice, failing which the Commission SHALL impose sanctions stipulated under the Second Schedule (Electoral Code of Conduct) of the Elections Act, 2011.
