**Re: Request for Information Regarding the Advertisement by the President's Delivery Unit from May 28, 2017 to August 16, 2017**

### **Purpose**

I write on my own behalf as a citizen of Kenya and on behalf of Katiba Institute for which I am the Executive Director. I am seeking information under Article 35 of the Constitution and the Access to Information Act 2016.

### **The Law**

As you are aware, Article 35 relates to right to information and the relevant part of that Article states:

35. (1) Every citizen has the right of access to—

(a) information held by the State;

...

(3) The State shall publish and publicise any important information affecting the nation.

The Access to Information Act 2016 has further elaborated on Article 35 rights and procedures of seeking information. Additionally, this request is also anchored on Article 33 of the Constitution which guarantees the freedom of expression.

### **Basis for Request for Information**

I have noticed, over several months now, that the President's Delivery Unit (PDU) has been undertaking a campaign on the identity and status of various projects undertaken by the current government generally under the messaging **#GoKDELIVERS** including those also tagged as **#JUBILEEDELIVERS**. I am interested in receiving information in regard to this advertisement campaign.

### **The Request**

Specifically I require the following information for the period starting May 28, 2017 to August 16<sup>th</sup> 2017 (inclusive):

- i. How many advertisements has the PDU published;
- ii. In what media/medium has the advertisements in (i.) above been published;
- iii. Schedule of dates when the advertisements were published with descriptive particulars for each advertisement;
- iv. Schedule of dates and the media/medium where each of the published advertisements was made;
- v. Copies of all those advertisements, including audio and video clips of those advertisements published on Television and Radios;
- vi. Total cost incurred by PDU or the relevant government accounting office(s) in publishing all these advertisements, as well as a particularized schedule of the cost for each advertisement published;
- vii. Name of individual/ agency or government office that met the respective cost of publishing each of the advertisements made.

I hope you are able to provide us with this information as soon as possible but not later than the time specified in the Access to Information Act 2016 for the production of information.
