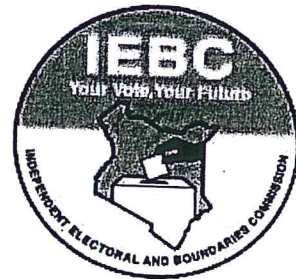

RE: THE FRESH PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS

We refer to the above matter, and the concerns raised by the National Super Alliance [NASA] vide its "Position Paper on Irreducible Minimums before the Fresh Elections are Held", dated 12th September, 2017.

First, we write and reiterate the Commission's unqualified commitment to deliver free, fair and credible elections, in strict compliance with the Constitution and the enabling electoral laws. Upon assuming office, the Commission has remained committed to meaningful stakeholder engagement and it is toward this end, that we have hosted consultative meetings between the Commission and the NASA Coalition as well as meetings with various other stakeholders to address the various concerns raised in guaranteeing a credible election.
